Program Description

Fellowships will be awarded to qualified engineering, science, mathematics or other related fields faculty members at minority institutions for 10-week summer research experiences at Goddard Space Flight Center (GSFC). Fellows will conduct projects of mutual interest to the fellow and GSFC. Fellows are encouraged to continue their research when they return to their universities, to include research concepts in their courses and also to encourage their students to pursue research in NASA-related fields.

Eligibility

Participants must be U.S. citizens and hold a research or teaching appointment at a Historically Black College or University (HBCU), Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI), Tribal College or University (TCU) or other Minority Institution (MI), preferably with two years of experience.

Applications

The application deadline is **April 21, 2003**. A completed application, including a Statement of Research Interests (250 words maximum), a Curriculum Vitae (CV) and two letters of recommendation should be sent to the following address:
